The above tuition covers all costs for the course. Lunch is not provided, however several eating establishments are within short walking distance.

In addition, there is a forty (40) hour Externship in a dental office for "practical on-the-job training" for a total of 120 course work hours.

Refunds, Cancellations

1. Cancellations must be made in person or by certified mail
2. All monies will be refunded if the school does not accept the applicant or if the student cancels within (3) three business days after signing the Enrollment Agreement and making initial payment.
3. Cancellation after the third (3rd) business day, but before the first class, will result in a refund of all monies paid, with the exception of the administration fee.
4. Cancellation after attendance has begun, but prior to 40% completion of the program, will result in a pro rata refund computed on the number of hours completed to the total program hours.
5. Cancellation after completing 40% of the program will result in no refund.
6. Termination Date: The termination date for the refund computation purposes is the last date of actual attendance by the student unless earlier written notice is received.
7. Refund will be made within 30 days of termination or receipt of cancellation notice.
8. A student can be dismissed, at the discretion of the Director, for insufficient progress, nonpayment of costs, or failure to comply with the rules.
9. Those wishing to cancel for illness or personal reasons may resume their course of study in the next class series with no penalty and may repeat the already completed sessions if desired at no additional charge or pick up where they left off.
10. For any program or course that is cancelled by the institution, the institution will refund the tuition in full or apply the tuition to a future course depending on the wishes of the student.
